

WHAT WOULD IT BE LIKE TO LIVE IN BRAZIL?

The aim of this activity is to find out what some of the different parts of Brazil look like and what it would be like to live in these places.

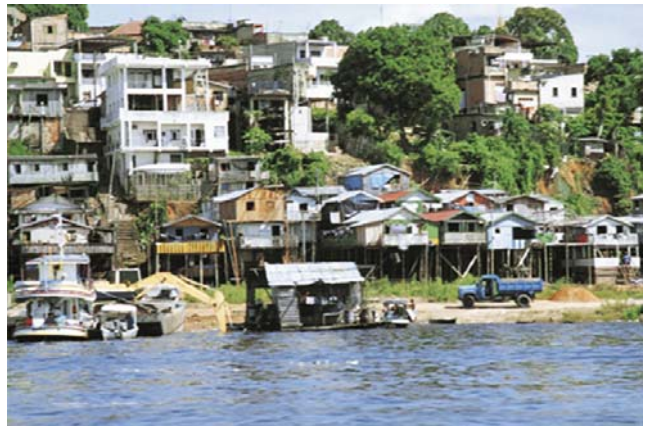
You will have to become a detective, using only photographs, your powers of deduction and your imagination to find out how people live in different parts of Brazil.

- Select two contrasting photographs of places in Brazil. For each picture develop annotations to describe and offer explanations for what the place is like. Start off with simple descriptive labels (maybe using the Development Compass Rose technique as a framework) then try to develop these ideas offering explanations linked to your labels.
- Write a comparison of the two places, picking out similarities and differences between the places. Try to explain these similarities and differences.

OR

- Imagine that you live in one of the places. Describe what your life is like and explain why it may be like this.
- How does life in the place you have described contrast with where you live? What are the similarities between these places and how might they be connected?

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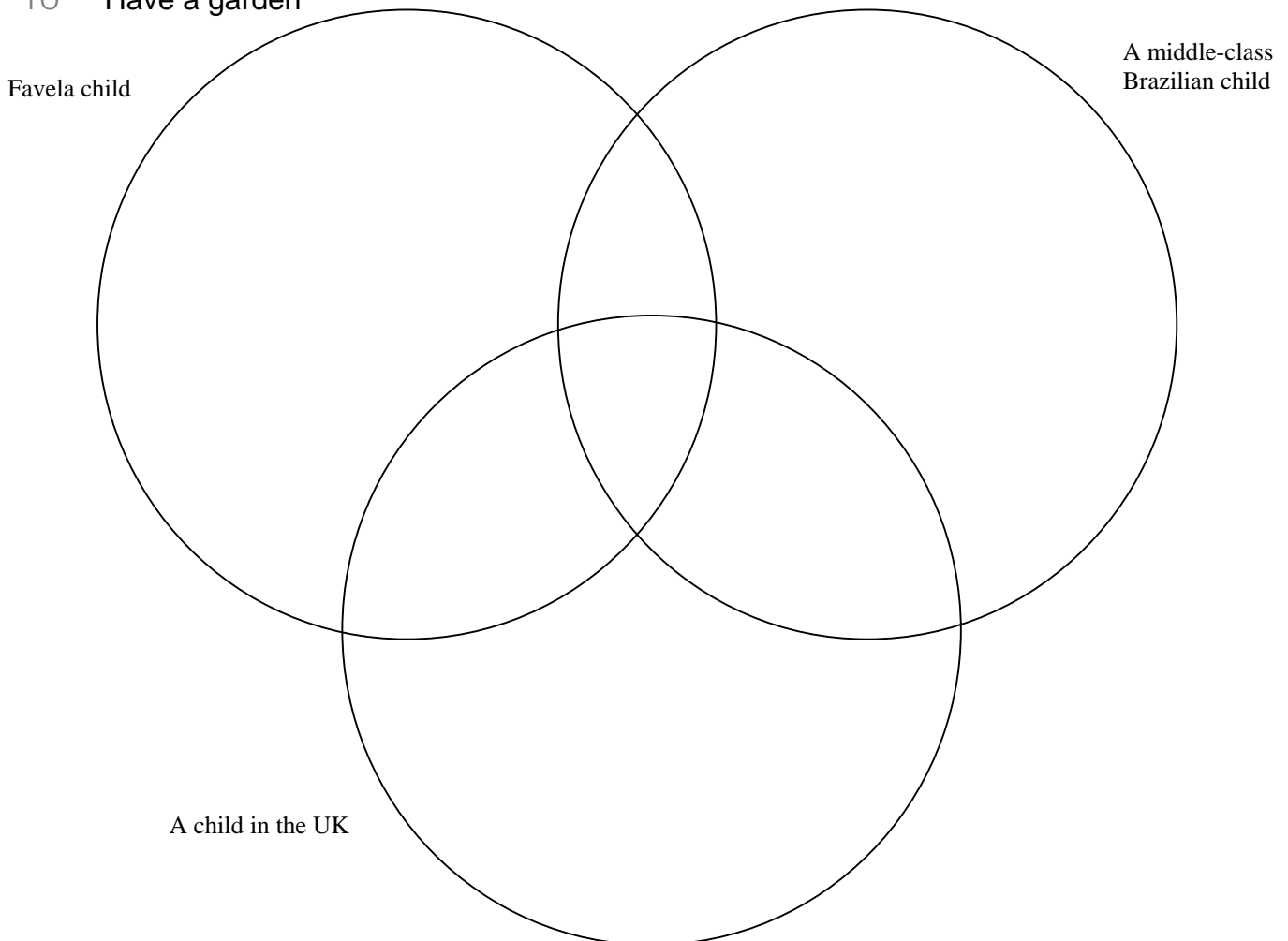


BRAZILIAN LIFESTYLES
